GRANT POLICY and GUIDELINES

The Jim and Juli Boeheim Foundation strives to enrich the lives of kids in need within our Central New York community, as well as, provide support for eliminating cancer through research and advocacy. The Foundation is committed to assisting organizations in need of funding to support innovative and creative projects and/or programs.

The Foundation Board of Directors will determine the total amount of funds available for project/program support annually, based on the financial performance of the Foundation. The amount of any single grant is based upon an evaluation of pending grant applications and the funds available. Grant renewals are not automatic and cannot be guaranteed from year to year. Grant applications will be evaluated on the merits of the proposal and the track record of the applicant in effective and efficient project/program delivery. The Foundation's goal is to respond to all grant applications within forty-five days.

All applicants are encouraged to review the Foundation's guidelines and confirm that there is a reasonable match between the grant request and the Foundation's mission and funding priorities. The Foundation welcomes applications from 501(c)(3), as defined by the Internal Revenue Service.

The Foundation will NOT provide support for the following:

- Organizations that discriminate on the basis of race, religion, gender, national origin, disability, age, marital status, or veteran status
- Organizations located outside the geographic boundaries of Central New York, unless the specific project has an impact on the residents of Central New York
- Organizations that spend more than 35% of their budget on overhead and fundraising
- Individual loans or assistance
- Endowments
- Political or lobbying organizations
- Social functions or advertising
- Projects or programs initiated before the Foundation's decision date

Please be aware that all grant applications will be reviewed by the Foundation's Board of Advisors as well as the NCAA compliance officer at Syracuse University.

Grant Timeline:

October 1 - October 31	Submission for Fall Grant Applications (go to: http://www.jimboeheim.com/foundation)
November	Notification of Fall Grant award or denial
December	Distribution of Funds
May 1 – May 31	Submission for Summer Grant Proposals (go to: http://www.jimboeheim.com/foundation)
June	Notification of Summer Grant award or denial
July	Distribution of Funds

To be considered for funding, the Applicant must submit a completed application. Send only the information that is requested and be concise in your responses. The Foundation contact will call if additional information is needed. Any application received after 4:30 p.m. on October 31st or May 31st will not be considered. New applicants and those not receiving grant funding in a previous cycle may re-apply for the next season's grant awards. Applicants who receive grant funding will be required to skip one grant cycle and then may re-apply.

An unsuccessful application does not necessarily reflect the worthiness of a particular project. The Jim and Juli Boeheim Foundation receives more requests than it can fund. The Foundation reserves the right to award any number of grants, or no grants, in its sole discretion. Nonetheless, any Applicant whose request has been declined is encouraged to contact the Foundation to discuss specific reasons for the rejection.

PUBLICITY AND MEDIA COVERAGE

The Jim and Juli Boeheim Foundation generally issues a press release concerning the award of grants immediately after the awards are determined. Grant recipients are encouraged to provide their own publicity after receiving a grant. Reference to the Jim and Juli Boeheim Foundation or use of the Foundation logo in any Applicant's publicity requires the prior review and approval of the Foundation. Grant recipients must agree to the use of the organization name, that of its officers and/or directors, photographic or electronic images, logos, trademarks or service marks, by and for the benefit of the Jim and Juli Boeheim Foundation in connection with the grant award.

GRANT AGREEMENT

Prior to applying for a grant, applicants are encouraged to review the terms of the grant that are outlined in the Grant Agreement. All grant recipients are required to submit a signed grant agreement before funds are distributed.
